# FLYING SUB

## **Photo-Etched Interior Upgrade**



#### Notes:

- Please note that this etched metal part is intended for advanced modelers only.
- Specialized tools (etched metal snips, etc.) are required (or will help greatly).
- It is suggested that you paint the Flying Sub interior before assembling.
- For easier assembly, install the windows (Seaview kit piece 90) before installing the completed interior assembly.
- This photo-etched kit contains through holes making it suitable for lighting. No electronics are included. (One white, 3mm LED placed on each side of the interior should provide sufficient light.)
- We suggest using cyanoacrylate adhesive (also known as CA or "super glue" the gel type works best).

#### Assembly:

- Fold the main compartment (1) as shown and cement the walls in position. Fold the port (left) side to match the right (starboard) which is already folded in the illustrations. Tabs at the base of the walls help in alignment to floor.
- Insert girders (2 and 3) into the slots provided in the walls. While cement is still wet ...

 Attach ceiling rings (4 and 5) to the girders and align the girders.

 Attach the completed assembly into the lower Flying Sub fuselage.
The opening in the rear fits over the display stand block and the two holes in the front fit over the studs for the pilot and co-pilot seats.

 Install pilot seats and upper fuselage half as shown in the kit instructions.

### **Optional - Engine Grills:**

- Rear engine grills (6) are included as optional accessories.
- Remove the existing engines with a 5/32 inch (0.156 inch, 4mm) drill bit.
- Glue the new engine grills in place.
